Oquirrh Elementary has a plan to improve instruction for all students. A complete outline of this plan may be accessed on Oquirrh's website and in a notebook located on the front counter of Oquirrh's office. Mandy Thurman, the principal, would be happy to address questions regarding this improvement plan and welcomes input regarding any ideas our community may have to improve our school. Below is a brief summary of Oquirrh's goals to improve:

Oquirrh Elementary will increase their scores by at least 35% from Jordan School District's ELA Pre-test to the ELA Post-test.

- Using the Utah Core Curriculum, and through targeted professional development, collaboration and coaching, teachers, coaches and assistants will thoroughly understand the grade level core curriculum that they teach and will identify the essential concepts on which they will focus their instruction.
- Utilize effective research-based intervention strategies or extended learning opportunities.
- Increase and improve parental engagement to improve literacy at school and at home.

Oquirrh Elementary will increase their scores by at least 35% from Jordan School District's Math Pre-test to the Math Post-test.

- Using the Utah Core Curriculum, and through targeted professional development, collaboration and coaching, teachers, coaches and assistants will thoroughly understand the grade level core curriculum that they teach and will identify the essential concepts on which they will focus their instruction.
- Utilize effective research-based intervention strategies or extended learning opportunities.
- Increase and improve parental engagement to improve mathematics at school and at home.

Oquirrh Elementary will reduce the number of inappropriate student behaviors requiring intervention by 10% each year.

- Maintain student attendance percentage greater than 93% for every subgroup.
- Develop a culture that encourages and rewards student social and academic achievement.
- Create a system of support to help all students and their families meet their complex needs through coordinated educational, health, human and community services.
