



## "Space-Available" Bus Permits

The State of Utah has determined that elementary school students who live within 1.5 miles of our school are ineligible for transportation. However, Jordan School District will allow ineligible students to ride the bus if space is available.

Due to the high demand for "Space-Available" bus permits, the School Community Council at Oquirrh Elementary has determined the following:

1. Parents who wish to apply for a "Space Available" bus pass must submit an application to Oquirrh Elementary during the first month of the school year. **Applications will be due at 9:00am on Aug 30<sup>th</sup>.** (Only one application per family will be accepted.)
2. The school will conduct a random drawing on or after Aug 30<sup>th</sup> to determine the students eligible for "Space-Available" bus passes.
3. Parents of eligible students will be notified by the 15<sup>th</sup> day after D-track has begun.
4. "Space-Available" passes are issued for the current year only. Bus passes will expire the following school year after the lottery drawing. Families requesting "Space-Available" bus permits **must apply each year.**
5. Students will be required to present their bus pass to the bus driver as they are boarding the bus.
6. **Passes may be withdrawn or revoked at any time** due to an increase in eligible riders or due to student conduct that does not conform to the rules for riding the bus.
7. Riders must use the existing bus stops. Additional bus stops will not be added to accommodate ineligible riders.

It is important to understand that Jordan School District is not allowed to transport students who have not been approved and assigned to ride the bus. Please adhere to the rules and regulations regarding "Space-Available" bus permits.
