

Oquirrh Elementary Safe Dismissal Plan

Please help us ensure that every student arrives at school and home quickly and safely each day. Use the map on the back side of this paper to see which dismissal zone your child will use at the end of the school day. **Please review the map with your child so they know where to go. Please also let your child's teacher know which zone your child will be using each day.** In order to ensure student safety, it is very important that students go home on the same route each day. It can be confusing and scary for a child when they think plans have changed. If you must make a change in your after-school route, please communicate in writing with your child's teacher. Thank you for supporting our students' safety.

Zone 1 - This zone is for families who will use the drive through drop off/pickup lane. After school, students will gather on the lines south of the kindergarten playground to wait for their rides. They will need to keep their whole carpool group together. Please help your child identify a last name for their carpool group that all students in the group will use. Please roll down your window and tell the first teacher on duty the last name so they can call for your students and have them ready to be picked up. **Please always pull all the way forward to the far end of the drive through drop off/pickup lane by the flag pole before your students get in/out of the car. Please stay in your car the whole time you're in this zone.** This helps us fit more cars and get everyone through safely and quickly.

Zone 2 - This zone is for students who walk south along Paddington Road. They will cross at the south crosswalk, where our student Safety Patrol will help them. West Jordan City Crossing Guards will help them cross at the intersection of Paddington Road and New World Drive.

Zone 3 - This zone is for families who would like to park in the southwest parking lot and walk their students across the center crosswalk. For safety, students will not be allowed to walk across the crosswalk without an adult. **This zone is not a drive through pickup/drop off lane. You must park your car in a parking stall and walk across the crosswalk to the sidewalk to pick up your child.** We will not release any students to cross the crosswalk and meet families in the parking lot. Please wait for your child behind the kindergarten wall to keep the sidewalk pathway clear.

Zone 4 - This zone is for students who will cross Paddington Road directly in front of the school with the West Jordan City Crossing Guard.

Zone 5 - This zone is for students who go to a daycare center. Students will line up behind the green posts and get on their daycare van as it pulls up.

Zone 6 - This zone is for students who ride bikes/scooters/skateboards, etc. and lock them in the bike rack. Students wait here for their whole group. Students should not cross in front of the school with equipment, and they should walk it until they have left school property.

Zone 7 - This zone is for students who qualify for bussing by living west of Bangerter Highway and at least 1.5 miles from the school, as well as those who have been approved through the space available bus permit system. If you live in this area but are not quite far enough away from the school to qualify for the bus, and you would like to apply for a space available bus permit, please come into our main office for an application. Additional special education buses also pick students up in this zone.

Zone 8 - This zone is for students who walk along the east side of Paddington Road to meet families who park at the Constitution Park's North parking lot or along the east side of the street. **Students may NOT cross Paddington Road from this area - only at the crosswalk directly in front of the school.**

Zone 9 - This zone is for students who exit behind the school through the opening in the east fence at the back of the field onto 3200 West.

Thank you for your help in keeping our students safe. **Students will be released at 3:20 M-Th and 12:45 on all Early Out days.** Students are not allowed to play on playgrounds during dismissal.
