N-Nothing is too small (All acts of kindness are great, big or small)


D- Do something about it (The best time to be kind is right now, so do something, say something, and make a positive difference for others).

meals is \$1.05 for breakfast and \$2.00 for lunch. Reduced lunch prices are .30 cents for breakfast and .40 cents for lunch. **Important Details:** 

- Free or Reduced Lunch Applications: These were included in your registration packets and are also available at the office. We encourage all families to apply to see if they qualify. Remember, you must reapply every year, even if you qualified previously.
- **Balances:** Any balances from previous years will carry over into the new school year. If there is an outstanding balance, please

ensure it is paid alongside the cost of meals your child will be consuming this year.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding in this matter. Ensuring all children have access to nutritious meals is a priority for us, and we thank you for your part in making this possible.

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# School Community Council Update

We are excited to announce the upcoming election for our School Community Council. At Oquirrh, the council is a vital committee that is comprised of of 4 parents, 1 teacher, and the school principal, that meets four times a year to discuss some of the needs of the school. By law, there must be 2 more parent members than school staff. Our purpose is to review school data, make essential decisions about safe walking routes, allocate School Land Trust funds, and discuss other crucial school-related issues. Council member terms are 2 years, and they must re-apply for their seats at the end of the time period, so half the parent seats are up for re-election each year. Teachers are also voted by their peers and serve for 2 years as well. School community members that have students in the school may nominate themselves or others for open seats. If we have more candidates than we have open seats, we must hold an election, with members being voted on by the school community. We sent the papers home asking for nominees in the Back to School packets and we have 3 candidates who wish to occupy 2 open seats, therefore we will be holding an election next week (Sept 16-19) in the main office. There will be a ballet box in the office near our visitor log. All votes must happen in person.

#### **Election Details:**

• Seats Available: 2

• Candidates: 3

• Voting Period: Monday to Thursday, next week

• Location: Ballot box in the main office

If you are in the school, we encourage you to participate in the voting process by turning in your ballot. The results will be announced on Friday, and the first meeting with the new council will be held on **September 24th at 4:30 PM** in the media center.
