

Oquirrh Elementary General PTA Meeting Minutes

PTA President Ashley Heber called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

Ashley brought up school shirts. All orders have now been distributed and we have a few more shirts ordered for people who didn't order in the first order. Teacher and Staff Appreciation is May 6-10. PTA has not finalized any plans but will probably do very similar things to the last few years: gift cards, chocolate fountain and Swig (or another drink place) for everyone. There is a parent that has a home bakery. She would like to provide something during this time. Ashley will contact her to get things arranged.

6<sup>th</sup> grade memory activity will need volunteers to help plan and supervise the activity. Tangela will email Ms. Harris to start getting plans moving.

Field day plans are starting. Ms. Ludlow will talk to Mr. Pedler to see if he is willing to help plan. We're hoping to make field day more exciting than it has been in past years, but we will need lots of parent volunteers to make that happen. PTA will have a treat for all students after their field day experience.

Ms. Ludlow hopes to start a monthly newsletter soon.
