To Apply	What to bring to your appointment:
ID	Driver's License, State ID, Residence card
SS Cards	For everyone living in your household
Utility bills	Last month's <u>Power and Gas</u> bills with account numbers
Income Verification	Proof of income for everyone working for the prior month
Birth Certificate	For children 5 years or younger
Medical Expenses	Receipts of any medical expenses for the last 30 days
Proof of:	Child support and/or alimony paid
Disability	Proof of disability (if applicable)
