New implementation of Programs and Training

- It was observed at the beginning of the school year that disruptive behavior was getting in the way of learning
- There 3 school wide rules were established-- Follow directions the first time, KYHFOOTY (Keep your hands, feet, and other objects to yourself and Use Kind words and actions-as a way to emphasize good habits
- Administration and teachers are working to create consistency across the grade levels for student behavior expectations, rules, and discipline
- One way of acknowledging good behavior is that classes can be given rays on mountain peaks. A complement earns a ray and 5 rays earns a prize
- School is providing positive reinforcement and incentives (mountain man tickets, school store, fluency challenge, walk to read point system)
- District behavior specialist visits the school every other month. Focus around positive behavior systems and training to help teachers implement in the classroom
