We will have a special Back to School Night only sale. If anyone purchases more than one youth shirt, they will be discounted to \$8. There will be a QR code available at the table so parents can sign up and pay for PTA.

Kinder Parent Social

Wednesday August 21, at 8:50am. It will last just about 15-20 minutes. Jen approved for this to be held in the library. Noel will get donuts. Holly will make a sign for the hallway outside the library to direct parents. Melissa will message teachers to send out a Dojo to parents, and Ashley will update the form for the teachers to send out through Dojo.

Color Run Fundraiser

This will take place in September and will be our main fundraiser of the year, replacing our usual school carnival. It also goes along with our school theme this year of "Race to Kindness." Kids will come in white shirts from home, and we will have some kind of alphabetical line up so siblings can run together. Teachers will have powder bottles that we will supply. We will also sell bags of colored chalk for \$5, if families would like to throw chalk.

We discussed collecting 6 leaf blowers to help blow off chalk when the kids are done. We will also have a first aide station with water and wet wipes. Jen will ask the school nurse if she would be available to volunteer for that station. The Color Run itself will be short, but we will then have prizes and food trucks to elongate the evening. We discussed putting signs throughout the neighborhood advertising the event and the food trucks. Jen will talk to Officer Knapp about possibly attending the event also.

We are doing class prizes instead of individual prizes, along with some fun school-wide grand prizes involving our awesome teachers. We brainstormed many ideas for these big prizes. Including, painting some of the teachers nails, pie in the face of a teacher, etc. These prizes will take place that night after the color run. Jen said she will send out a sign up or put one on the fridge for the teachers to volunteer to do something crazy for the kids.

Other topics briefly discussed:

We will do an online Panda Express Spirit Night on October 29th, and possibly add swig or Ritas to the list. Ashley discussed Reflections. She will make fliers for Jen and videos for the teachers to show.
